<i>Educational objective:</i> The Teamwork Skills MOOC (IO2) will cover topics such as: The course focuses on teamwork. The lessons will help you become a better team member in any organisation you may be part of. <i>Assessment procedures:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each topic has a digital study material in text and video to continue. • Each topic has a short test, which must be completed with at least 80%. The homework is to write 3 studies after every 4th lesson and after completing the practice tests, a final test must be completed.	
Material	
The goal is to understand the role of teamwork and individual work, and to recognize when which form is most effective. It is important to learn about the development stages of teams and how team dynamics work, and to develop social skills - especially in terms of empathy, active listening and assertive communication. The development of effective team communication, the giving and receiving of constructive feedback, and the strengthening of leadership skills are given priority. With the help of brainstorming techniques, it becomes possible to generate creative ideas while learning about different types of teams, including virtual, remote forms of collaboration.
